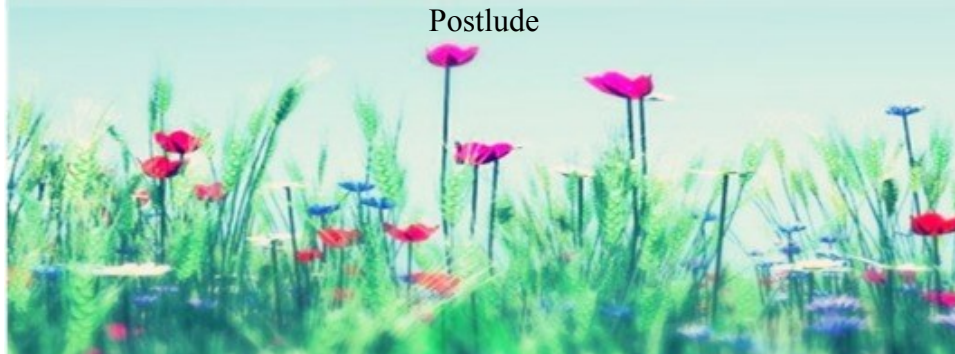

Jeduthun was a court musician in David's and Solomon's day (1 Chronicles 16:41-42; 2 Chronicles 5:12). This title or inscription at the head of the psalm indicates that it was meant to be set to music for corporate worship.
